AGING WITH GRACE

Our furniture are ready for you to use as soon as it arrives, so there is no initial need to treat it or clean the leather.

With the right treatment your furniture will last for generations and age gracefully.

LEATHER

As a natural material, leather requires looking after. Over time, and if taken of carefully, the leathers will soften and develop a wonderful patina that will contribute to the unique beauty of the product.

Yellowstone / Elegance / Horizon

Avoid placing the furniture in direct sunlight and excessive heat.

Vacuum the leather with a soft brush attachment when necessary.

For more intensive cleaning, avoid detergents and instead use a gentle foam of lukewarm water and soap flakes. Apply the foam with a dry soft cloth, minimizing any contact with water.

Matstone

Avoid placing the furniture in direct sunlight and excessive heat.

Vacuum the leather with a soft brush attachment when necessary.

Never use soap or water, as the velvety look and feel may disappear. Do not apply leather grease or soak the leather.

A suede eraser can be used to effectively get rid of stains without damaging the leather. Use the suede eraser on the Matstone leather in the same way you would use a pencil eraser.

WOOD

A thin film of conditioning oil such as linseed oil can be applied to the wood to rehydrate the fibres. We recommend that you apply oil every 6 to 12 months, but if your furniture looks particularly dry you may want to re-oil. Be sure to apply oil to all sides of the wood.
